

## Directions to the Camp Meeting

### From West Virginia

From I-77 take 460 East and you will come into Christiansburg, Virginia. You will exit to the right on 460 East Business Downtown. Stay in the right lane. This will turn into North Franklin Street. You will go through six (6) stop lights. (Note: North Franklin Street turns into South Franklin Street.) After the last stop light you will see Sunset Cemetery on the right. You will pass five (5) houses on the right. The church is on the right and the sign is near the road. The camp is located on the grounds of the Bible Holiness Church.

### From I-81 North or South

Take Exit 114 and go toward Christiansburg on Main Street. There will be five (5) stop lights. At the fifth stop light, take a right onto South Franklin Street, go through one (1) more stop light and continue on South Franklin. You will see Sunset Cemetery on the right. You will pass five (5) houses on the right. The church is on the right and the sign is near the road. The camp is located on the grounds of the Bible Holiness Church.
